How do I become a client?

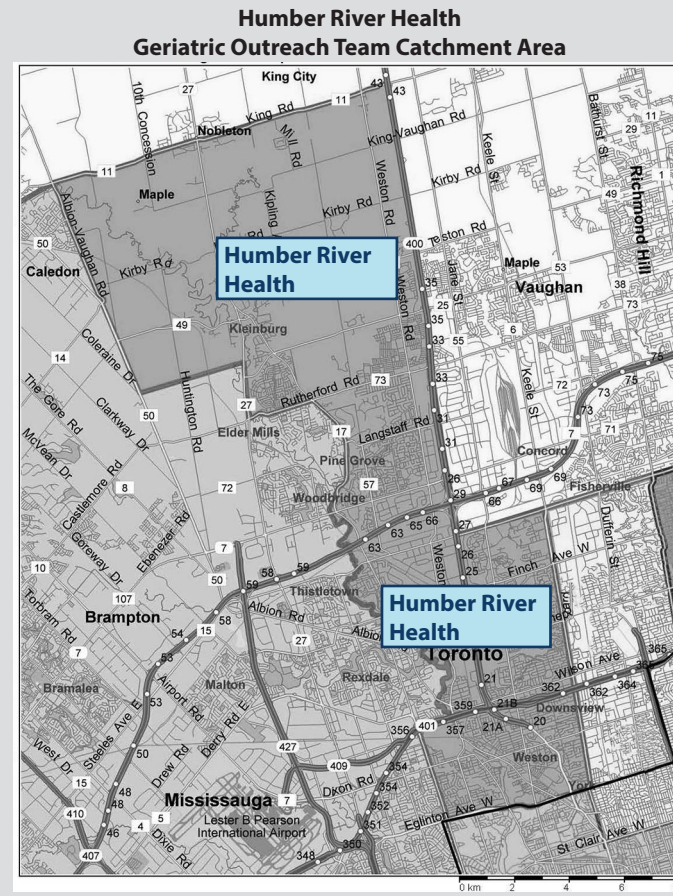
To become a client, you can:

Humber River Health's Geriatric Outreach Team works together with the Regional Geriatric Program to meet the needs of the most frail and vulnerable seniors.

We perform in-home assessments of age-related issues and offer solutions to help seniors maximize their health, independence and quality of life.

Team Members

Our interdisciplinary team includes:

- Geriatrician
- Nurse Clinician
- Occupational Therapist
- Social Worker

All of our team members are skilled in geriatrics and senior-friendly care.

In-Home Assessments

One of our team members* will visit you at your home and complete an assessment based on the issues that you are experiencing. This will help us to better understand your overall health and level of function.

* Please note: Our geriatrician does not do home visits.

Some issues we address are:

- Home safety
- Trouble managing day-to-day activities
- Multiple medical problems
- Frequent falls or problems walking
- Memory changes
- Changes in mood
- Lack of social supports
- Trouble handling your medicines

At the end of the visit, we will share our recommendations with you. This may include linking you to community partners, doctors, specialists, or other senior or health services.

Is this for me?

Our services are for clients who:

- Are 65 years of age or older
- Have a valid Ontario health Insurance Plan (OHIP) card
- Live within the Humber River Health catchment area (see map on back).
